Welcome Aboard

Funding for the Comox Valley Transit System is cost shared between the Comox Valley Regional District and BC Transit. Decisions on fares, routes and service levels are made by the regional district board based on public feedback and information provided by BC Transit. Buses are operated by Watson & Ash Transportation Co. Ltd.

Operating costs are met by a combination of farebox revenues and joint regional district and provincial funding.

About Your Transit System

There are three types of transit services:

Fixed-route transit - conventional buses offer scheduled service to major destinations and residential areas.

Community bus - door-to-door service for residents in certain areas not served by the fixed-route service.

handyDART - door-to-door service for people who cannot use the fixed-route service because of a disability.

Transit Pass Tax Credit

Government of BC Bus Pass Program

A universal bus pass is available for low-income seniors and persons with disabilities, providing unlimited access on any scheduled BC Transit bus. To qualify for the BC Bus Pass Program, you must be receiving:

- Federal Old Age Security (OAS) and Guaranteed Income Supplement (GIS);
- Spouses Allowance to Old Age Security;
- Over 65 years – would qualify for OAS and GIS except having less than 10 years residency in Canada;
- Income Assistance (60-64 years); or
- Income Assistance for persons with a disability

Riding the Bus

Priority Seating

Although BC Transit serves everyone on a first-to-board basis, priority seating is considered to be the front accessible area of the bus. Priority seating meets the needs of all transit customers, and is especially vital to:

- customers who use scooters, wheelchairs, pediatric strollers or other mobility aids,
- customers with a disability or mobility issue, and
- customers with baby strollers.

Please be courteous and offer your seat.

Baby Strollers

As a parent or guardian you must hold onto the stroller at all times. Position the stroller with the brakes set. Keep your stroller clear of the aisles. The aisle is the width of the distance between the normal seats, not the width of the accessible area.

Strollers should be collapsible. When wheelchair positions are occupied or required by another passenger using a wheelchair or scooter, you may fold the stroller and move to another available seat, storing the stroller between the seats.

Bike Racks

Bike racks are designed to assist longer commutes. Instructions are posted on the rack. Bike space is limited to two bikes and cannot be guaranteed. Bike racks on a Community Bus can only be used during daylight hours as bikes can block the headlights.

Transfers

A transfer allows travel for the next connecting bus. A transfer cannot be used for a return trip. Request a transfer when you board and pay your fare. Show your transfer to the driver, face up, with time showing.

Pets on Board

Only small fur-bearing and feathered pets contained in secure, clean, hand-held cages are permitted on the bus. Cages (hard or soft shell) must be small enough to fit on the owner's lap.

Passengers must hold onto their cages at all times. If there is room, the passenger may place and hold the cage beside them on the floor. The cage should not block the aisle or restrict other passengers.

Assistance animals that are certified are allowed on public transit at all times.

Request-a-Stop

After dark, customers who feel that their personal safety is at risk can ask their driver to stop between regular bus stops. Ask your transit driver at least one bus stop ahead of where you wish to get off. You will be let off at a safe location closest to your request.

Be Safe, Be Seen

It can be difficult for transit drivers to see you at bus stops, especially along unlit roads. Wear light-colored clothing, wear a reflective strip or use a flashlight or the light from your mobile phone to signal the driver that you are at the stop.

Attendants

Customers using wheelchairs or scooters, registered handyDART customers or CNIB passholders may travel with an attendant. Please let your transit driver know if the person travelling with you is your attendant. Attendants travel free and must board and exit at the same stop as the customer requiring assistance and help to load and secure mobility aids on the bus. Your driver will need to ensure that the securements are properly fastened.

Community Bus

The community bus provides door-to-door service within the specified areas. Passengers will have an opportunity to travel to major exchange points and transfer to and from conventional Comox Valley Transit service.

Booking a Trip

You must book your trip 48 hours before you wish to travel. Call during office hours, or leave a message on the voice mail after hours.

There are two types of bookings accepted:

- **One Time Trips:** trips for other purposes such as shopping, social visits or recreational activities.
- **Regular trips:** for trips once a week or more often, such as for therapy appointments or to and from work.

Community Bus Service

The times listed below show the approximate times when service will be available to Cape Lazo/Point Holmes area and Huband Road/Seal Bay areas.

Service operates Monday through Friday, excluding Statutory Holidays. When you book your trip, the dispatcher will provide you with an estimate of your pick up and drop off time. The dispatcher will also help you coordinate transfers onto the conventional Comox Valley Transit system.
