Transit Tips

Here are some courtesy and safety tips to keep in mind while travelling on the bus.



Always

- ✓ plan to arrive at the bus stop a few minutes early
- ✓ have your correct fare ready before boarding
- ✓ take a seat as soon as possible after boarding
- ✓ hold on while the bus is in motion
- ✓ be a good neighbour – yelling or loud music on the bus can be distracting for the driver and other passengers

Never

- ✗ stand in the street or sit on the curb when the bus approaches
- ✗ run after or hit the side of a moving bus
- ✗ allow your children to stand or kneel on the seat while riding the bus
- ✗ enter the street in front of or directly behind a stopped bus – make sure traffic can see you
- ✗ use offensive or abusive language on the bus

Kimberley Transit provides fully accessible local request service on route **24 Kimberley Local** as well as regional service to Cranbrook on routes **21 Kimberley/Cranbrook** and route **22 KC Commuter**. During winter months, service to the Kimberley Alpine Resort is also provided on route **23 Peak to Platzi Ski Shuttle**. Winter service schedules are posted at bctransit.com/Kimberley leading up to winter months.

Local Service

Door-to-door On-Request Service is available Monday to Friday, 8:00am to 4:30pm. Call one business day ahead to book your trip. For regular trips, once a week or more, call once to set up. Office hours are Monday to Friday, 8:00am – 4:00pm.

About Your Transit System

Funding for your local transit system is cost shared between the City of Kimberley and BC Transit for service within Kimberley and cost shared with the City of Kimberley, Kootenay East Regional Hospital District, Interior Health and BC Transit for service to Cranbrook.

Decisions on fares, routes and service levels are made by the local partners based on public feedback and information provided by BC Transit. Buses are operated by Kimberley Transit Society.

Operating costs are met by a combination of farebox revenues and joint local partners funding.
