Important Information—Please Read

Due to the popularity of our tours, we are only able to offer one tour per group/organization, per year (subject to availability). Tours last about 1 hour and take place at our 520 Gorge Road East location.

Children must be able to:

- Walk on their own (we are unable to accommodate mobility assistive devices, strollers or crutches)
- Navigate stairs (we lend a helping hand)
- Wear one of our child-sized BC Transit safety vests at all times

The tour will start promptly at the agreed time and once the tour leaves the main building, late arrivals will not be able to catch up (we will be in restricted areas of our property).

We strongly encourage groups to take transit when traveling to/from our office however, if this is not possible, there are strictly enforced parking limitations, so please read carefully:

- Provided they are available during the time of the tour, two visitor parking spaces located at the front of our building may be used (if you choose to park in either of these spaces, please check-in with our receptionist and inform them of your license plate and make/model of your vehicle)
- Limited/timed parking is available along Garbally Road and within the neighborhood area
- If traveling in a school bus, please park the bus on Garbally Road and walk with the children to the front of our building along main roads (rather than disembarking while the bus is on Gorge Road, blocking a traffic lane)
- Please ensure drivers **DO NOT** turn off Gorge Road down into our back parking lot, as this is a restricted access area for our buses and employees only

It is not mandatory, but is much appreciated if the children arrive with name tags on.

If we do not receive confirmation of your tour group booking, we will have to release the allotment to another group. Please ensure your confirmation is clear and timely.

Please remember to keep the tour details a surprise from the children, as it makes for a more memorable experience!
