Using Umo – Redeeming Your Youth Pass

Umo App Set Up:

1. Create an account.
2. Select Redeem Benefit Code from the top menu.
3. Tap Change Agency to select your transit system
4. Enter the provided benefit code to link your pass to your account.
5. As the bus nears, open the app and select Code to display your dynamic QR code for validation aboard the bus.

Umo Card Set Up:

1. Visit ca.umopass.com to create an account and register your card.
2. Once inside your account, click on the left menu, select Change Agency and select your transit system.
3. Next, select My Wallet, Redeem Benefit Code, and enter the provided benefit code.
4. As the bus nears, get your card ready to tap at the validator as you board.

You'll know your fare was accepted when you see and hear the validation signals on the Umo validator. A green checkmark signals your fare was accepted and a yellow checkmark signals your fare was accepted but your pass will expire within three days.
