
Kitimat Transit



Accessible Transit

All buses are accessible. Low-floor buses have no entry steps and are equipped with a ramp. A 'kneeling' feature further lowers the entry level for passengers who have mobility difficulties.

Bikes and Scooters

Most bikes can be accommodated on BC Transit buses when its wheels fit properly in the rack. If you are considering travelling by bike and transit, instructions are posted on the bike racks or found at bctransit.com/victoria/riderinfo.

Before your bus arrives, make sure that saddlebags, antennas, helmets, child carriers or any other item that could interfere with the operator's vision are removed from the bike. Electric bikes are only allowed on the bike rack when they weigh less than 25kg (55 lbs.), and the battery (lithium only) is removed from the bike and brought on board the bus with the customer. Electric scooters are allowed on board if they can be folded and stored between the seats or held.

Paying Your Fare

Go with Umo

It's your choice how to use Umo app or card. Buy passes or load a Cash Balance through the app, online at ca.umopass.com, Umo's customer service line at 877.380.8181, or at a vendor location.

Cash Fare

Cash is still accepted on board. Please have the exact fare ready before you board the bus.

Umo Cash Balance

Cash Balance is a new fare product for riders using a Umo payment method. A rider's Umo app or reloadable card can be loaded with a set dollar amount to be drawn from as additional trips are taken.

A Cash Balance can be loaded from \$5.00 and up.

A transfer allows for travel on the next connecting bus within 90 minutes of trip departure without incurring an additional fare. A transfer issued is valid on any local routes in the Kitimat, Terrace, and Skeena transit systems, but it is not valid on 11 Kitimat-Terrace Connector.

If paying with cash, please request a paper transfer from the bus driver at the time of payment and submit the transfer to your next driver upon boarding your second bus.

▶ An electronic transfer will be automatically applied to your Umo payment method. Please tap or scan your original Umo payment method on your second bus to continue to travel without incurring an additional charge.

Kitimat handyDART

handyDART is door-to-door shared-ride service for people unable to take conventional transit. The handyDART vehicle is accessible.

Customers must first register. Registration is free.

Phone 24 hours ahead. Same day requests may be accommodated.

For trips between 7 a.m. and 8:30 a.m. and between 5 p.m. and 7:30 p.m. it is recommended to pre-book the day prior.

You can also book subscription trips for regular appointments and programs. If your plans change, phone as soon as possible so we can schedule a trip for someone else.

Free Transit for Children 12 and Under

Children aged 6 to 12 ride conventional and handyDART buses for free, without requiring a fare product or identification.

Children 5 and under will need to be accompanied by an attendant 12 years or older to ride for free. Children must board and depart at the same stop as the attendant.

Welcome Aboard

Kitimat has three kinds of service: conventional service within Kitimat, handyDART service and regional service through Skeena Regional Transit.

Fare Zones

There is one zone for Kitimat conventional service. There are two zones for handyDART service. Zone one is between Kitimat River and Minette Bay Road and including Strawberry Meadows. Zone two are trips across the Kitimat River, across Highway 39, Hirsch Creek Bridge to Cable Car and a separate regional zone and fare structure for regional service.

Funding for Kitimat Transit is cost shared between the District of Kitimat and BC Transit. Decisions on fares, routes and service levels are made by the District of Kitimat based on information and planning provided by BC Transit. Kitimat conventional, handyDART and Skeena regional service buses are operated by Keolis Canada.



Signal Your Bus

In some rural communities that do not have physical bus stops, customers can "wave" down the bus from a safe location. A safe location is one where visibility is good and where the bus can easily pull off the road.

A driver may not be able to safely stop for you if the posted speed limit exceeds 60 km/hr.

As this service operates primarily on the highway where the posted speed limit exceeds 60km/hr, it is **strongly recommended** that customers use designated bus stops.

Be Safe and Be Seen

Sometimes it is difficult for transit drivers to see you at bus stops, especially along unlit roads. Wear light coloured clothing, wear a reflective strip, use a flashlight or use the light from your mobile phone to signal the driver that you are at the stop.
