#### 1. Introduction

The City of Merritt and BC Transit are developing the Merritt Transit Future Service Plan (TFSP). The TFSP builds from priorities identified in the 2016 Service Review, which was the last strategic plan for the Merritt Transit system. The purpose of the TFSP is to:

- Present a service scenario focused on implementing change over the next 1-5 years.
- Develop a cohesive regional transit plan to incorporate the Transit Vision and Goals for the City of Merritt.
- Identify improvement options to transit service to carry forward.
- Focus on changes to be made in the short to medium term, with additional priorities identified for the longer term.
- Ensure synergy and alignment with previous planning and transit studies completed including the 2016 service review and consideration of the 2022 City of Merritt Official Community Plan.

## 2. Background

The development of the TFSP began in 2023. The first step included discussions between BC Transit (planning and government relations) and Merritt local government partners regarding timelines and project expectations. Next, a review and analysis of the existing transit service was prepared, incorporating ridership statistics, existing service span, existing service frequency, as well as transit policies and goals in Merritt's guiding plans including the 2022 Official Community Plan, 2021 Active Transportation Plan, and the 2016 Merritt Transit Service Review. Using this information, in October and November 2023, BC Transit and the City collaborated on an engagement process to assist in developing short, medium, and longer-term service options for the area. The engagement process included discussions with key stakeholders and an online survey. The remainder of this document presents the results of this engagement process and the next steps in the process.





## 3. Engagement Methods

In October and November of 2023, operator engagement, a public survey, and 'pop-up' kiosk-style booths provided Merritt residents, employees, and students an opportunity to provide information desired services, priorities, and travel behavior to specific destinations within Merritt. In total, approximately 140 people participated in the engagement process. This information is further summarized on the following page. An extensive media awareness initiative was conducted to promote the open houses. Media included website customer alerts, flyers on buses and around the City, Facebook posts, Instagram posts, X (formerly known as Twitter) posts, and two Merritt Herald newspaper advertisements which were available both online and on paper. The survey and 'pop-up' kiosk booth boards are included in **Appendix A Public Survey** and **Appendix B 'Pop-up' Kiosk Booth Boards**.

## 4. Findings – Operator Engagement

The following key takeaways were gathered from the operator survey (see **Appendix C Operator Survey Responses** for full results):

#### Total participants: Four

- Most common type of riders are commuters, seniors, and students
- More route coverage needed to:
  - Coldwater Ave. west, which will help people who are finding it difficult to walk the distance, including seniors with mobility issues, to the exchange downtown (Mamette at Voght)
  - Coldwater Indian Reserve
  - o Armstrong St., which will help people who are finding it difficult to walk the distance to Menzies St. to catch the bus
- Route change desired to allow route 23 to travel to Bob's Mini Mart before Collettville south. An alternative would be to return to the pre-flood routing.
- More service desired to Lower Nicola on Sundays (one suggestion was 10am-2pm) and late-night at least from Monday to Saturday
- More frequency desired on all routes (route 1 North End, route 23 Collettville-Diamond Vale, and route 4 Lower Nicola), including route 23 Collettville-Diamond Vale 7:15am trip when taxicabs are being used by Merritt citizens as route 23 does not run at this time
- Service on statutory holidays is very valuable
- Could add more running time to route 4 Lower Nicola and route 1 North End, perhaps on route 1 inbound before it becomes the route 4 around 2:12pm, or the route 4 inbound
- Operations/fleet-oriented comments:
  - o Belshaw St hill is difficult for the bus to go up in the snow
  - Space on the buses for wheelchairs, strollers, and mobility aids such as walkers and crutches, as well as space for bike racks are well used

The BC Transit transit planner for Merritt also spoke one-on-one with operations staff members. The key findings are as follows (see **Appendix D Operations Staff One-on-One Conversation Notes** for full list of notes):

#### Total participants: Five

- Route 4 Lower Nicola Sunday service is desired
- Route 4 Lower Nicola late-night service on weekdays and Saturdays is desired
- More frequency on route 23 Collettville-Diamond Vale is desired
- Service desired through the Bench neighbourhood, Public Works yard on Coldwater Ave., and along Armstrong St.

## 5. Findings – Public Survey

This section contains a summary of what we heard in the survey. There were 83 survey responses, 13 of which were filled by hand. **Appendix E Public Survey Response Report** contains the full survey responses report.

#### **5.1 Demographics**

The online survey asked detailed demographic and travel pattern questions to help inform service design by building a picture of how and which residents use transit. The tables below show the responses, and the most common response is highlighted.

13% of respondents identified as belonging to additional equity-seeking groups, 46% of whom specified that they are a deaf person, person with disabilities, and/or person living with mental illness.

#### 5.2 Travel Behaviour

A majority of respondents use route 1 North End bus (37 people) while 28 said they use route 23 Collettville-Diamond Vale, 21 said they use route 4 Lower Nicola, 7 said they use On-Request, and 22 said "Not applicable/Don't use the service" (percentages are not provided as each respondent could select more than one route for their response). The frequency to which respondents use Merritt Transit service was nearly evenly distributed between multiple times a week (26%), a few times a year (21%), and never (25%). Slightly fewer respondents said they use the service a few times a month while only 5% of respondents said they use the service once a week. When asked "What do you use transit for", most respondents said shopping (42 people) and recreation/social activities (35 people), followed by medical/wellness appointments (29 people) and work (28 people).

#### 5.3 Service Satisfaction




Figure 1. Service satisfaction by respondents of different age groups.




Figure 2. Service satisfaction by respondents with or without a disability.

62% of respondents said they were either very satisfied (27%) or satisfied (35%) with the Merritt Transit service overall, while 12% said they were not satisfied and 5% said they were very unsatisfied. 63% of respondents said they find the transit service to be either very reliable or reliable. 4% said the service was very unreliable. Figures 1 below shows service satisfaction responses by age group, and figure 2 shows service satisfaction by respondents with or without a disability.

#### **5.4 Transit Improvements**

The survey found that while only 2% of respondents reported feeling unsafe or very unsafe when using the Merritt Transit service, there were suggestions for transit improvements geared to safety. These included the desire for more stops so that people do not have to walk as far in the dark, and stop location improvements as some stops may currently be in unsafe locations due to traffic. Bus stop amenities improvements that respondents mentioned included better lighting and shelters, garbage cans, and benches for all stops.




Figure 3. Respondents were asked how valuable to existing and potential riders a route 23 Collettville-Diamond Vale extension would be along Quilchena Avenue, Main Street, and Canford Avenue (or similar), adding about 5 minutes per trip.

Respondents were asked how valuable to existing and potential riders a route 23 Collettville-Diamond Vale extension would be along Quilchena Avenue, Main Street, and Canford Avenue (or similar), adding about 5 minutes per trip (see figure 3).

75% respondents said this would be valuable for existing or potential riders, while 13% said it would not be valuable for existing or potential riders. Comments included:

- "I have disabled family members that live on that route and would use the bus if it was that close. Walking to Voght st is not an option."
- "Have this route every hour like the other routes.
   Twice a day it doesn't run at certain times but if you're working, you can either be 2 hours early or 1/2minutes late. Depending on what time."
- "This is a good temporary option. When the bridge is built on Voght Street, the previous (pre-flood) bus route from City Centre through Riverside should be re-established."
- "Don't add more routes, add more schedules on the existing routes"




Figure 4. Residents were asked how valuable to existing and potential riders a new route would be along Voght St, Nicola Avenue, Juniper Drive, Parker Drive, Grimmett Street., and returning along Castillou Crescent (or similar).

Residents were asked how valuable to existing and potential riders a new route would be along Voght St, Nicola Avenue, Juniper Drive, Parker Drive, Grimmett Street., and returning along Castillou Crescent (or similar). Please refer to figure 4.

67% of respondents thought this would be valuable, 22% of respondents said it would not be valuable, and 11% said it was not applicable to them. Comments included:

- I don't use transit but probably would if Bench route added.
- A need, and too many parents drive their children to school
- Typically this is a higher income neighborhood that would be less likely to use public transportation

#### **New Route**

- I'm guessing there are seniors up there that would appreciate the bus being closer.
- Don't add more routes, add more schedules on the existing routes
- Doesn't connect to services in the north end. Extend service to NVIT/hospital
- It might be better if it could actually loop into the hospital grounds
- This is a good idea, but Riverside and Coldwater First Nation should be prioritized before this Bench route.

Respondents were asked how valuable to existing or potential riders they think adding route 4 Lower Nicola weekday and Saturday late-night service would be, with last trips leaving exchange downtown (Mamette at Voght) at 10:30pm, and leaving Rocky Pines at 10:44pm. 90% of respondents thought this would be valuable, 4% of respondents said it would not be valuable, and 6% said it was not applicable to them. Comments included:

- I have a friend who gets off work late and is never able to use the bus to get home to lower nicola since it stop going at that time.
- I see a big cost for little ridership
- Route 4 is almost worthless right now because it runs so seldom. it needs several more schedules
- I think it's Great for the people who work late or don't have the money for a taxi home, We need Late night service again
- Good idea. Eliminating potential drunk driving
- Yes we need night service and Sunday service

When asked about service prioritization, the top three most popular options to prioritize were (from most to least popular):

- Routing extensions to serve more areas
- 2. Adding trips later in the day was ranked equal in priority as increasing frequency of trips.
- 3. Bus arriving on time

Several survey respondents commented on routing needed in various other neighbourhoods or locations not specifically included in the survey. The most common responses included:

- Coldwater Indian Reserve
- Sage St and Clapperton Ave

## 6. Findings - 'Pop-up' Kiosk Booths

Public engagement booths were set up for 2 or more hours at the Conayt Friendship Society, Nicola Valley Institute of Technology, the Merritt Public Library, and Civic Centre. Please see **Appendix B 'Pop-up' Kiosk Booth Boards** for the boards that were set up at the booths during the events. The most common feedback was as follows:

- Bus stop improvements including more shelters, more bus stops in general, and safer stops (lighting, review safety of stop locations)
- More service to Lower Nicola needed, especially in evenings/late night
- There is interest in Coldwater Reserve service
- Overall support for the Bench and Coldwater Ave west of Voght St routing options
- More service to Antko 21 Reserve is needed

#### 7. Other Notes

There is a shelter at 4010 Walters St Olympic Villas which was likely constructed by the condo developer, though the bus does not currently stop there. A couple of survey comments and the City of Merritt provided feedback that this shelter should be used as a bus stop.

While fare changes are outside the scope of the TFSP, it is worth mentioning that at the 'pop-up' kiosk booth events, one person suggested it would be better if monthly fares could be bought at any time of the month and prorated based on the date, and another person suggested a fares review.


## 8. Overall Key Findings

Throughout the engagement events, the following key themes emerged (from most popular to least popular):

- 1. Service is desired connecting the Coldwater Ave west area to the exchange downtown (Mamette at Voght)
- 2. People want late-night service and Sunday service to Lower Nicola
- 3. Higher frequency is desired on all routes
- 4. Stops could be closer together with more amenities like shelters to protect from the elements

## 9. Next Steps

The engagement process for the Merritt Transit Future Service Plan (TFSP) has been a collaborative process between the City of Merritt and BC Transit. The data from the engagement process has been analyzed, and the next step is to use this information to assist in drafting service change priorities to continue to support transit ridership in the area. The focus will be on service change options for the short to medium term, with additional priorities identified for the longer term. These service change options will help to form the final TFSP document.



## **Appendix D Operations Staff One-on-One Conversation Notes**

Total participants: Five

#### Service improvement options from OpCo perspective:

- Four participants said route 4 Lower Nicola Sunday service is needed, though one person said they didn't think this was necessary.
- A couple participants said they hear the need for route 4 Lower Nicola late night service like the pre-flood schedule both on weekdays
  and Saturdays. In particular, workers in fast food industries are interested in this late night service. One NVTS staff person said this
  would be good but there is very low ridership on route 4. Operations Administration indicated late-night service on route 4 would work
  from a staffing perspective.
- One person said route 23 needs more frequency
- One person said service is needed through the Bench neighbourhood
- One person said service to Armstrong St is needed
- Three participants said they preferred the pre-2021 route 2 Collettville because it served deeper into Coldwater Ave by the Public Works yard and over Main St Bridge to serve more people. One of these participants said that people are tired of having to catch the bus to the exchange downtown (Mamette at Voght) and ride all the way to south Collettville and back just to get to Bob's Mini Mart (timing point E), and drew out an alternate option below in Figure 4. Two operators did not think the Main St Bridge service routing option made as much

sense as the existing routing, mostly because they felt the south Diamond Vale portion of the trip along Midday Valley Rd and Houston St.




Figure 5. Shows option provided by one operations staff members. Collettville neighbourhood portion of the proposed routing is shown in yellow; Diamond Vale neighbourhood portion of the proposed routing is shown in purple.

• It was confirmed that it is not an issue to find operators on statutory holidays. No one who I spoke with was interested in reallocating statutory holiday service hours to service elsewhere.

#### Other Information:

• Staff confirmed flag stops are only permitted on route 4. Otherwise, riders are supposed to board and alight at proper bus stops















- Everyone was supportive of the two routing options proposed (Bench neighbourhood and Coldwater Ave west of Voght St)
- Need interregional transit service. Lots of women hitchhikers to Logan Lake.
- Need Route 4 Lower Nicola late night service reinstated (we used to have it before the 2021 flood)
- Walmart and NVIT may be the most popular destinations
- Three people mentioned that Antko 21 needs service
- Need fixed routing connecting Nicola Meadows to Walmart, Library, and the hospital
- Two people mentioned Coldwater Reserve needs a fixed route
- Interregional service: Service needed in addition to Health Connections to Kelowna and Kamloops, as Health Connections only takes you sometimes, and Ebus is too expensive for many people

## **Custom Transit:**

• Would be nice if there was more OnRequest service, even if just in winter, to help for instance Antko 21 residents.

## Operator Feedback:

Some operators need to slow down on route 4

## Stops:

- · Better lighting at bus shelters including at NVIT
- Bad to stop at Johnny's and Fire Hall. Hard with traffic, especially in winter

## Routing:

- More frequency on route 1
- Increased density in Lower Nicola means we need more service including in evening
- We also need service to North Bench area (not just the Bench/South Bench area)

## Regarding the Bench route option:

- Two people said they liked it, but needs to serve NVIT too because of the density of multi-family homes there.
- One person concerned that given the older demographic of the south Bench/Bench option, ridership on this route if implemented may be too low as people take their own vehicles everywhere, or else would use handyDART.

## Safety on buses:

- In winter the back lights of the bus are hard to see
- Some elders slip when entering and exiting the bus more lighting needed by the lower step
- Difficult for pedestrians, cyclists, and drivers outside the bus to see the driver's facial expressions or hand gestures perhaps better lighting in the drivers seat would be possible and improve this issue?

#### Other:

• General interest in the bus, as well as some folks saying they're not very interested in the bus. One person said they used to take the bus but since getting their own vehicle they don't.
