

## Paying Your Fare

### Contactless Payment Method

Interac, Visa, Mastercard, and American Express cards are accepted. Cards linked to mobile wallets are also accepted.

### Go with Umo

If you travel frequently, we recommend purchasing fare products with Umo app or card to save money. Buy passes or load a Cash Balance through the app, online at [ca.umopass.com](http://ca.umopass.com), Umo's customer service line at 877-380-8181, or at a vendor location.

### Cash Fare

Cash is still accepted on board. Please have the exact fare ready before you board the bus.

### Umo Cash Balance

Cash Balance is a fare product for riders using a Umo payment method. A rider's Umo app or reloadable card can be loaded with a set dollar amount to be drawn from as additional trips are taken.

A Cash Balance can be loaded from \$5.00 and up.

### DayPASS

A DayPASS is valid for unlimited local travel within the Quesnel Transit System the transit day of purchase.

- ▶ If paying with cash, request a DayPASS from the transit driver and deposit the exact change into the farebox.
- ▶ If using a contactless payment method, Umo app, or Umo card, a digital DayPASS will be automatically applied to the same payment method after your second payment of the day.

### Government of BC Bus Pass Program

The BC Bus Pass Program is offered by the Ministry of Social Development and Poverty Reduction. The annual bus pass is valid for the eligible rider on any fixed-route transit service. ### Post-Secondary Student and U-PASS

If you are a student in full-time attendance at a post-secondary institution, you may be able to buy a college monthly bus pass. Check with your school's office.

U-PASS gives all CNC and UNBC students at the North Cariboo Community Campus unlimited access on Quesnel Transit. U-PASS holders have free

general admission to the Quesnel and District Arts and Recreation Centre. The semester fee is mandatory. For more information, consult your student society representatives.

### Fare Free Transit for Children 12 and Under

Children aged 6 to 12 ride conventional and handyDART buses for free, without requiring a fare product or identification.

Children aged 5 and under will need to be accompanied by an attendant 12 years or older to ride for free. Children must board and depart at the same stop as the attendant.

## Safety

### The Bus is a Safe Place

Transit drivers can contact local police, ambulance and other emergency services. Transit drivers are also trained to assist a child or adult in need. Tell the driver if you are concerned about your safety.

BC Transit's safety and security practices uphold the *British Columbia Transit Act* and the *B.C. Motor Vehicle Act*.

### Be Safe and Be Seen

Sometimes it is difficult for transit drivers to see you at bus stops, especially along unlit roads. Wear light coloured clothing, wear a reflective strip, use a flashlight or use the light from your mobile phone to signal the driver that you are at the stop.

### Request-a-Stop

Customers who feel that their personal safety is at risk can ask their driver to stop between regular bus stops. Ask your transit driver at least one bus stop ahead of where you wish to get off. You will be let off at a safe location closest to your request. Please contact your local transit office for details and any time restrictions.

## Accessibility

### Attendants

Customers using wheelchairs or scooters, registered handyDART customers or CNIB pass holders may travel with an attendant. Please let your transit operator know if the person travelling with you is your attendant. Attendants travel free and must board and exit at the same stop as the customer requiring assistance and help to load and secure mobility aids on the bus. Your driver will ensure that the securements are properly fastened.

## Welcome Aboard

Your local transit system runs six days a week. Buses serve the City of Quesnel and Electoral Areas "A", "B", "C", "I" of the Cariboo Regional District.

**Fixed-route service** – scheduled service to major destinations and residential areas.

**handyDART** – door-to-door, shared service for people who are unable to take the fixed-route service.

### About Your Transit System

Funding for your local transit system is cost shared between the City of Quesnel and BC Transit. Funding from the City of Quesnel is in partnership with the Cariboo Regional District.

Decisions on fares, routes and service levels are made by the City Council based on public feedback and information provided by BC Transit. Buses are operated by Passenger Contracted Transportation Services Ltd.

Operating costs are met by a combination of farebox revenues and joint regional district and provincial funding.

## handyDART

handyDART is a door-to-door shared transit service for people unable to take fixed-route transit.

handyDART service is available within the City of Quesnel and the surrounding area defined by the Cariboo Regional District handyDART taxation boundary.

### Hours of Operation

Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

### How to Register

Passengers must first register by calling 250-992-1109. There is no fee for registration. Registrants will be asked to provide their name, address, phone number, date of birth, emergency contact and any medical facts handyDART should be aware of. This information will be kept confidential. A medical confirmation of your disability may also be required.

### Booking a handyDART trip

Call 250-992-1109 during office hours. Try to book 24 hours in advance. Same day requests may be accommodated. If you need to cancel a trip, phone as soon as possible so others can be accommodated.

## handyDART Fares

Zone 1 – \$3.00 – within city boundaries and the portion of Red Bluff serviced by conventional transit.

Zone 2 – \$6.00 – all areas outside of Zone 1 and up to approximately 10 km from city boundaries, including the communities of Bouchie Lake, Ten Mile Lake, Barlow Creek and Dragon Lake.

Zone 3 – \$9.00 – all areas outside of Zone 1 and 2 up to the taxation boundary, including Kersley.

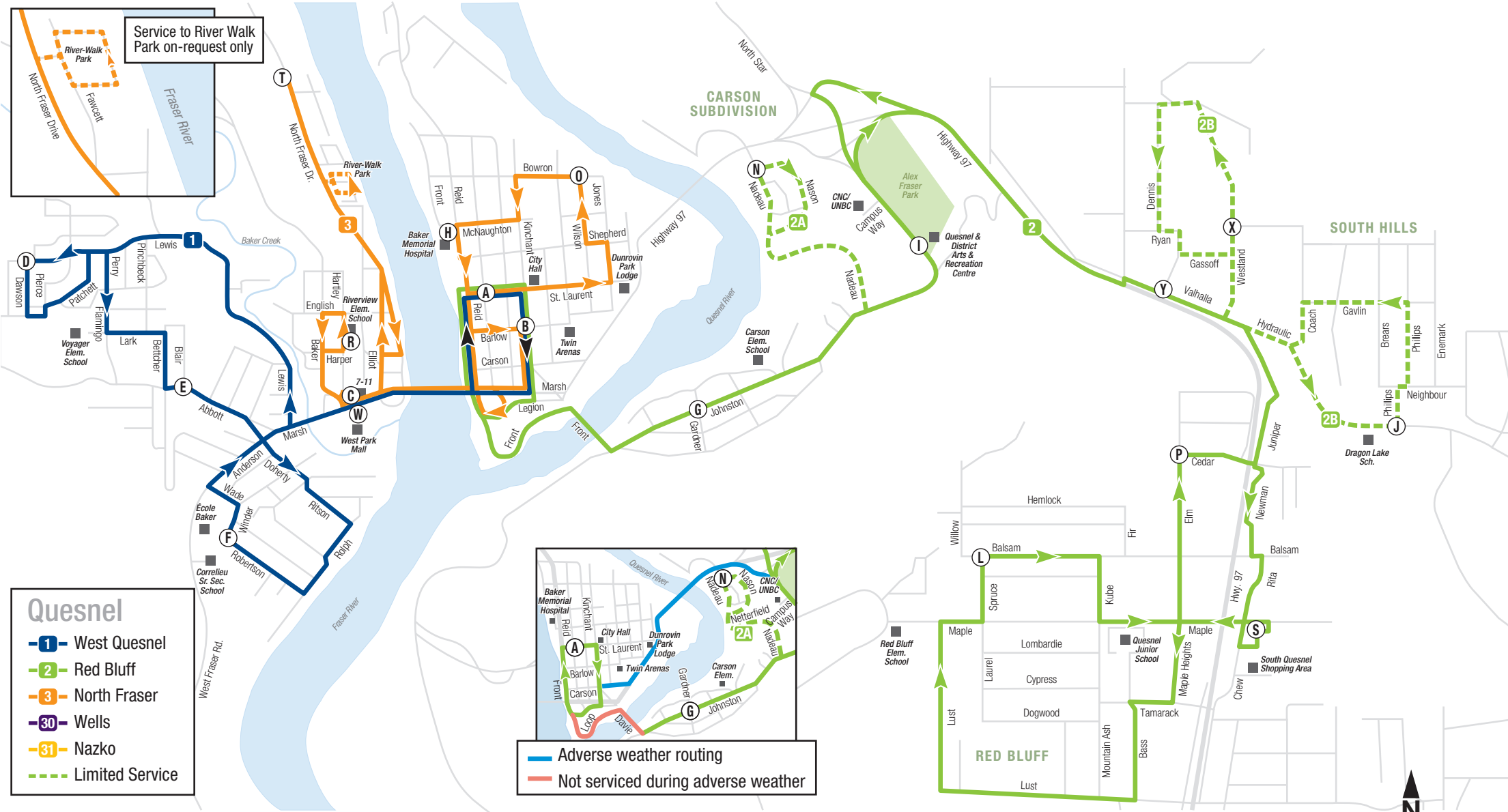
