Welcome Aboard

Your local transit system runs six days a week. Buses serve the City of Williams Lake and the Cariboo Regional District.

Fixed-route service – scheduled service to major destinations and residential areas.

handyDART – door-to-door, shared service for people who are unable to take the fixed-route service. handyDART serves Williams Lake and the Cariboo Regional District areas.

About Your Transit System

Funding for your local transit system is cost shared between the City of Williams Lake and BC Transit. The Williams Lake Transit System also acknowledges the contributions and support of the Cariboo Regional District and Williams Lake Indian Band to the success of the system.

Decisions on fares, routes and service levels are made by City Council and the CRD Board based on public feedback and information provided by BC Transit. Buses are operated by Passenger Contracted Transportation Services.

Operating costs are met by a combination of farebox revenues, and local government and provincial funding.

Pass Programs

Government of BC Bus Pass Program

The BC Bus Pass Program is offered by the Ministry of Social Development and Poverty Reduction. The annual bus pass is valid for the eligible rider on any fixed-route transit service. The pass is non-transferable.

handyDART

handyDART is a door-to-door, shared ride transit service for people with disabilities that prevent them from using fixed-route transit.

How to Register

Passengers must first register. Registration is free. Registrants will be asked to provide their name, address, telephone number, date of birth, an emergency telephone number and any relevant medical facts. Medical confirmation of your disability may also be required. This information will be kept confidential.

Hours of Operation

handyDART service operates Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. and Saturday between 10:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.

Booking a handyDART Trip

At other times, a telephone answering service will provide recorded information. Visit bctransit.com, under Williams Lake, handyDART for more information.

Passengers are asked to be prepared for their trip before the bus arrives.

Wheelchair, Scooter and Mobility Aid Guideline

handyDART vehicles have a side ramp or a rear lift that can accommodate most common wheelchairs or scooters. Your wheelchair or scooter must meet weight and safety guidelines. Your mobility aid should not exceed a combined weight of 250lbs for manual wheelchairs or 600lbs for motorized mobility aids. If you have any questions or concerns about the size of your mobility aid on handyDART, contact the handyDART office or see the Mobility Aid Guide online.

Free Transit for Children 12 and Under

Children aged 6 to 12 ride conventional and handyDART buses for free, without requiring a fare product or identification.

Children aged 5 and under will need to be accompanied by an attendant 12 years or older to ride for free. Children must board and depart at the same stop as the attendant.

Health Connections is a transit service providing communities with accessible transportation options for non-emergency medical appointments. Although medical appointments have priority, everyone can use this service if space is available. All passengers one-way fare: \$5.00

The bus will leave Williams Lake on **Monday only** at 7:30 a.m.

The bus will leave Kamloops on Monday only at 3:00 p.m.

All customers must call 250-398-7812 or 1-866-933-7812 and confirm their seat by the previous Friday.

For stops between Williams Lake and Kamloops, approximate pick up times will be provided at time of booking.
