Appendix A – Service Expansion Priorities Victoria Regional Transit System: Priority Service Improvement Needs

The Transit Evaluation Matrix scores and ranks proposed transit expansions on a wide range of criteria. Key inputs include productivity of route - with 30 per cent of the score determined by population served and ridership. Another key consideration is whether the transit expansion is a critical system fix, accounting for 25 per cent of the score.
