Whereas Commissioner Caradonna, at the request of Victoria City Council, provide the following background information:

In February of 2025, Victoria voters approved the Crystal Pool replacement project and associated borrowing amounts via referendum. Construction is likely to commence in 2026 or 2027, and would last for three years, creating interrupted service to a facility that witnesses 400,000 unique visits per year. Many users arrive via transit and/or will need to use transit to access other recreation centres across the region. On 27 March 2025, as part of a suite of responses to this interrupted service, and in an effort to mitigate impacts on rec centre users, Victoria City Council directed the two members of the VRTC to bring a motion to the Transit Commission related to the transit service of the Crystal Pool.

Be it resolved,

That BC Transit staff consider options to alter transit routes, on a temporary basis, to accommodate Crystal Pool users during periods of interrupted facility services related to the redevelopment of the facility.
