- handyDART provides door-to-door service for people unable to ride the scheduled service
- On-Request provides curb-to-curb service to Wyndhaven, Sunshine Valley, and Lower Blackpool areas

Funding for Clearwater Transit is cost shared between the District of Clearwater, Thompson Nicola Regional District and BC Transit. Decisions on fares, routes and service levels are made by the District of Clearwater based on information provided by BC Transit.

Buses are operated by the Yellowhead Community Services Society.

Government of BC Bus Pass Program

The BC Bus Pass Program is a program offered by the Ministry of Social Development and Poverty Reduction. It offers an annual bus pass for low income seniors and individuals receiving disability assistance from the Province of British Columbia. The pass is valid for the eligible rider on any fixed-route transit service. The pass is non-transferable.

The BC Bus Pass is not valid for HandyDART.

handyDART

handyDART is door-to-door, shared transportation within Clearwater for people unable to use the scheduled service. Passengers must register and pre-book their trips 24 hours ahead. Registration is free. Register between 8:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m. There is a pre-trip orientation for new riders.

Service is available Monday - Friday, 10:00 a.m. - 11:00 a.m. and 1:45 p.m. - 2:45 p.m.

Booking

Before you call, be ready with the following information: name and telephone number, pick up and destination location, time of travel and any mobility equipment (e.g., wheelchair).

If you are using a wheelchair, be sure it is equipped with a lap belt.

Please be ready to travel a few minutes before the scheduled pickup. The driver will wait for five minutes past your scheduled time.

2 Blackpool

Passengers can request curb-to-curb service to Wyndhaven, Sunshine Valley, and Lower Blackpool communities on **2 Blackpool** trips.

Trip Times:

Monday through Friday

Wyndaven – 9:05 a.m., 1:15 p.m., 4:10 p.m.

Sunshine Valley – 9:15 a.m., 1:20 p.m., 4:25 p.m.

Lower Blackpool – 9:20 a.m., 1:25 p.m., 4:30 p.m.

These times are approximate.

Booking Trips

To book a pickup in Wyndhaven, Sunshine Valley, or Lower Blackpool, call 24 hours ahead during office hours (8:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m.). You can also book your return trip at the same time. The bus can make only one deviation on each **2 Blackpool** trip.
