4. CHAIR'S REMARKS

The Commission is excited to be the first community in the province to pilot electric buses. The 40-foot BYD battery-electric bus will be entering revenue service shortly and is available for viewing after the meeting.

5. 2017/18 FINANCIAL AND PERFORMANCE REPORT - for APPROVAL

Passenger and advertising revenues were \$1.3 million above budget at year end. Expenses were \$10.1 million below budget at year end, primarily due to fuel being \$3.14 million lower than expected and timing of payments related to the Douglas Street bus priority lanes. The Transit Fund ended the year at \$3.8 million.

The Operating Reserve Fund (which can be used to offset inflationary impacts of existing service) ended above budget at \$19.4 million.

6. 2019/20 SERVICE EXPANSION – for APPROVAL

To align with the investments and targets identified in the Transit Future Plan, it is recommended that the Commission purchase eight buses and approve an additional 20,000 service hours for implementation in the Fall of 2019. A workshop session is proposed for later in the fall to review each of the proposed enhancements in more detail and determine which initiatives to move forward with either through expansion or re-allocation of existing service hours.

Motion by Mayor Atwell and seconded by Mayor Finall to APPROVE the additional buses and service hour expansion in principle, with a Commission discussion to take place at the next meeting to review options to allocate those hours.

The volume of construction activity in the Region has impacted transit service reliability, primarily due to buses running behind schedule and missing connections. BC Transit and municipal staff are working continuously to respond to service issues as they arise.

Of special note, the success of Car Free YYJ continues to grow and this year the attendance was comparable to Canada Day fireworks with equal requirement for additional service.

Fall service changes include seasonal increases in service to match ridership demand and an expansion of 10,000 annualized service hours. September 2018 will include the addition of two

new routes to the transit system. The first is the Route 9 connecting Camosun College Interurban campus with the University of Victoria. The second is the Route 87 servicing Dean Park and Sidney. The report also highlighted a number of service enhancements to the Saanich Peninsula, including routes that service the Victoria International Airport.
