

FALL 2018 CHANGES -

Effective September 4, 2018



Changes include the addition of two new routes.

- 9 UVic / Royal Oak via Gorge/Hillside: A crosstown route Gorge-Hillside that connects the Camosun College Interurban Campus with the University of Victoria.
- **87 Dean Park**: A route through the Dean Park neighbourhood that connects the Saanichton Exchange, McTavish Exchange and Downtown Sidney.

There will also be some minor changes to routes serving the Peninsula.

- 81 Brentwood/Sidney/Swartz Bay/Saanichton: routing and schedule changes
- 83 Sidney/Brentwood/Royal Oak: routing and schedule changes
- 85 North Saanich: introducing weekend service
- 88 Airport/Sidney: schedule changes to provide connections with 72 Downtown/Swartz Bay

9 Royal Oak / UVic via Gorge/Hillside


FALL 2018 CHANGE: Effective September 4

Change Overview:

 The 9 Gorge / Hillside will provide service between Royal Oak Exchange, Camosun Interurban, Tillicum Mall, Hillside Mall, Camosun Lansdowne and UVic via Hillside and Gorge

Key Benefits to Change:

- Provides improved service to Camosun College Interurban Campus with key trips for class start times
- Provides new crosstown route that supports Transit Future Plan network vision



Routing Change — Route 81 81 Brentwood / Sidney / Swartz Bay / Saanichton

FALL 2018 CHANGE: Effective September 4

Change Overview:


 The Route 81 will stay on Lochside Drive between the McTavish Exchange and downtown Sidney.

Key Benefits

- Consistent routing and frequency through Canora neighbourhood
- Improved transit service on Lochside Dr.

Considerations:

 Canora neighbourhood no longer has access to route 81. Service levels and connections will be maintained through Routes 87 and 88. As a result, there will be little impact to customers.



Routing Change — Route 83 83 Royal Oak / Sidney

FALL 2018 CHANGE: Effective September 4

Change Overview:


 The Route 83 will stay on West Saanich Road and turn onto Mills, no longer service the Victoria International Airport. On weekends, Route 83 will be extended to Royal Oak to match weekday routing. Service levels should be maintained.

Key Benefits

 Consistent routing on weekdays and weekends

Considerations:

- Route 83 no longer services the airport – these resources have been reallocated to Routes 87 and 88
- Canora neighbourhood no longer has access to Route 83. Service levels and connections will be maintained through Routes 87 and 88. As a result, there will be little impact to customers.

85 North Saanich


FALL 2018 CHANGE: Effective September 4

 Introduces service to the Dean Park neighbourhood, a neighbourhood not currently served by transit

Change Overview:


 Service improvements are being made to 88 Airport/Sidney to provide 30-minute weekday service, 60-minute weekend service and connections with the 72 Swartz Bay/Downtown.

Key Benefits

- Provides consistent service to the airport and improves frequency on weekdays
- Provides timed connections for customers travelling between Downtown Victoria and the Airport

Considerations

Service span reduced to provide improvement



How are Service Changes Developed?

Service changes are based on:

- The system's long term <u>Transit Future Plan</u>, recent <u>Victoria Regional Service Review</u> and 2018/19 Annual Service Plan.
- Recent feedback from customers, front line staff, major employers and area local governments.
- Detailed route analysis and application of the system's service design standards and route performance guidelines¹ to best match service to customer demand.

Appendix A

Excerpt - Victoria Regional Transit Service Standards and Performance Guidelines

Minimum Service Standard

Service frequency defines the minimum frequency at which a route operates, subject to meeting the Performance Guidelines. Investments to increase service levels will be considered to strategically develop the network or when route performance indicates the route is performing 25% above the target for the routes class.
