### 5. UNMET handyDART SERVICE STATISTICS Paul MacDonald

Paul presented current handyDART service statistics:

- May 2019: 926 unmet trips half of what was unmet in April 2019
- June 2019:601 unmet trips

# 6. OPPORTUNITY FOR SEIZURE EDUCATION AND TRAINING FOR BC TRANSIT Deirdre Syms

Seizure and epilepsy education and seizure response training offered to both the Committee and to BC Transit's Safety and Training department.

Request for increased handyDART service to Sooke.

The committee was informed that at this time there is not capacity to increase handyDART service to Sooke; however, it is a prominent issue that the Victoria Regional Transit Commission is aware of.

## 8. DISABLED CUSTOMER TRAINING FOR OPERATORS

#### Mairi Chester

Issues regarding requests made to Operators for ramp lowering, lack of courtesy seating signage on some buses, and denied service due to strollers brought forward to committee. Training for Transit Operators and community education discussion included:

- Education at pre-natal clinics and classes recommended to better assist customers utilizing strollers
- Invisible disabilities
- Further integration and recognition training for specific customer disabilities (autism, epilepsy, mental health etc.) and the difficulties customers encounter
- BC Transit's potential to lead awareness and education for disabilities
- Committee can bring forward input and advice for Transit Operator training with accessibility issues and disabilities for BC Transit to apply
- Policies recognizing disabilities

#### **ACTION:**

- A. Customers are encouraged to communicate any requests to the Operator, and if these requests are met with concerning responses to contact

- B. Customers requiring courtesy seating can request the Operator to ask for seats to be made available; however, an Operator cannot enforce customers to move. Customers are encouraged to refer to the BC Transit Rider's Guide for the Courtesy Seating and Baby Strollers guidelines.
- C. BC Transit send meeting invitation to Safety and Training Representative for next Committee meeting September 27, 2019 to discuss training process and potential adjustments

- Positive feedback from the committee included that there would be better visibility during both the day and night.
